## NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 18(1) AND 23(4) OF THE EXTRADITION ACT 1999

## Whereas

- On 1 September 1999 the Extradition Act 1999 (the Act) came into force;
- Part 3 of the Act applies to the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA** by virtue of it being party to the Treaty on Extradition between New Zealand and the United States of America 1970 (the Treaty);
- On 18 January 2012 the North Shore District Court issued a provisional warrant for the arrest of **KIM DOTCOM** pursuant to section 20 of the Act and Article XI of the Treaty;
- On 1 March 2012 a formal request from the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA** for the surrender of **KIM DOTCOM** was transmitted to the Minister of Justice in accordance with section 18 of the Act;
- Section 23(4)(a) of the Act provides that the hearing of the proceedings must not proceed until the court receives from the Minister of Justice a notice in writing stating that a request for the surrender of the person has been transmitted to the Minister under section 18.



NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 18(1) and section 23(4) of the Extradition Act 1999, I hereby notify the North Shore District Court that a request for the surrender of KIM DOTCOM to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA has been transmitted to me by the authorities of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in accordance with the provisions of the Act.
