DAVID: NO I DON'T BECAUSE AT THE END OF THE DAY THE NUMBERS DON'T LIE AND WHOEVER IS IN GOVERNMENT, AND I TELL YOU WHAT HERE'S SOMETHING NEW, I DON'T THINK THE BEST WAY THROUGH THIS GIVEN THAT IT IS A 50 HUNDRED YEAR PROBLEM AND THERE WOULD PROBABLY BE TWENTY DIFFERENT GOVERNMENTS IN THAT TIME, IS THAT THERE SHOULD BE SOME KIND OF CROSS PARTY ACCORD ON THE LONG-TERM PROBLEMS OF SUPERANNUATION

PATRICK: WELL YOU'RE NOT GOING TO GET ONE WITH WINSTON WANTING IT AT 65, NATIONAL WANTING IT AT 65...

DAVID: I'M HERE TO TALK ABOUT LABOUR POLICY NOT NZ FIRST POLICY MATE, SO IF YOU ASK ME A QUESTION ABOUT LABOUR POLICY I WILL GIVE YOU A GOOD STRAIGHT UP ANSWER.

PATRICK: I WILL ASK YOU ONE, YOU SAID YOU WANT TO BUY BACK ASSETS IF YOU CAN, WINSTON PETERS WANT TO DO THE SAME, 30 PER CENT OF GENESIS IS SITTING RIGHT THERE

DAVID: YOU REALLY HAVE A THING ABOUT WINSTON PETERS THIS MORNING HAVEN'T YOU

PATRICK: WELL YOU WILL AS WELL IF HE HOLDS THE NUMBERS.

DAVID: YES BUT I WILL DO IT AFTER THE ELCTION

PATRICK: WILL YOU LOOK AT BUYING BACK THAT 30 PER CENT OF GENESIS

DAVID: WELL IM GLAD YOU RAISED GENESIS BECAUSE WHAT A SHAMBLES HONEST TO GOODNESS ME. FIRST THEY SAW THE REFEREDNDUM, TWO THIRDS OF NEW ZEALANDERS TWO TO ONE SAID NO MORE SALES, AND THEY SAID THEY'D CARRY ON.

PATRICK: IT'S ABOUT LABOUR POLICY

DAVID: YEAH IT'S ABOUT LABOUR POLICY AND FORGIVE ME FOR CHUCKLING A LITTLE BIT BUT THEY DON'T EVEN THINK THAT THEY CAN POSSIBLY GET AWAY FIFTY PER CENT OF THE SHARES BECAUSE THE LAST TWO ELECTRICITY COMPANIES THAT THEY SOLD WERE SUCH DOGS, THEY ARE THE WORST PERFORMING SHARES ON THE SHAREMARKET AND THEY'RE GOING TO BRIBE NEW ZEALANDERS WITH TAX PAYERS MONEY TO GET THE SHARES AWAY. HOW ILLOGICAL IS THAT

PATRICK: YOU TOLD ME TO ASK YOU ABOUT LABOUR PARTY POLICY. YOU WENT AROUND THAT ELECTION CAMPAIGN FOR LEADERSHIP THAT YOU WOULD BUY BACK THE ASSETS, THERE'S THIRTY PER CENT OF GENESIS SITTING RIGHT THERE. WOULD THE LABOUR GOVERNMENT BUY IT BACK?

DAVID: FANTASTIC THIRTY PER CENT OF GENESIS, FIFTY PER CENT OF MERIDIAN, FIFTY PER CENT OF MIGHTY RIVER POWER AND KIWIS WANT THEM STATE OWNED AND THEY WANT TO MAKE SURE WHAT'S LEFT STAYS...

PATRICK: IS LABOUR GOING TO BUY THEM BACK?

DAVID: WE MAY WELL BUY SOME BACK, I AM COMMITTING TO BEING A FISCALLY RESPONSIBLE PRIME MINISTER AND PART OF A FISCALLY RESPONSIBLE GOVERNMENT. SO AGAIN WE'LL JUST HAVE TO SEE WHEN WE GET THERE HOW BAD THE BOOKS ARE, WHAT WE CAN AFFORD, WHERE WHEN THE BEST DEALS COME UP

PATRICK: WILL YOU OR WON'T YOU

DAVID: WHY WON'T YOU BUY X ASSET ON Y DATE FOR Z DOLLARS OF MONEY. YOU KNOW THAT I CANNOT POSSIBLY ANSWER THAT QUESTION PATRICK AND IT WOULD BE ABSOLUTELY IRRESPONSIBLE TO DO SO. HERE'S WHAT IM SAYING PLAIN AS ANYTHIHNG, SURE WE ARE GOING TO PROTECT THE EXISTING STATE ASSETS, WE WOULD LIKE TO BUY SOME BACK, WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO DO SO, WE WILL LOOK FOR COMMERCIAL OPPORTUNITIES. IM NOT GOING TO EXPROPRIATE PEOPLES SHARES FOR NO PAYBACK, WE'RE NOT GOING TO NATIONALISE IN THAT SENSE. WE'LL LOOK FOR SOME OPEN MARKET OPPORTUNITIES AS THEY COME AND WE WILL LOOK TO STRENGHTEN THE CROWN'S NET ASSET BACKING.

PATRICK: AS SOON AS POSSIBLE?

DAVID: AS SOON AS AFFORDABLE
